
Background

- Importance:
 - Wealth of local data-rich case studies (i.e. Oshogbo)
 - Under-utilized
 - Publish or perish landscape
 - Publication industry less robust than in West
- Expedient need:
 - Space constraints
 - Lowered budgets
 - Conservation concerns
- Long term value and academic support:
 - Increase access on-site and off-site
 - 2017 MSU study

- **SALTOC** (South Asia ToC); hosted by NYU, under umbrella of CONSALD. LC Jakarta is an active participant

- Handbook of Latin American Literature; LC; began 1934


QUARTERLY INDEX TO AFRICANA PERIODICAL LITERATURE


Full Scope of Project—How to Winnow

From 36,347 to 13,287 unique titles







Decision: Nigerian Education Journals

Of the first round of journals pulled:


~20 titles contained 4 or more issues per title

~100 tiles contained between 1 and 3 issues per title









Irregularity Example





Tracking solution






Setting Interns Up For Success

Work Space

- Resources needed: computer, access to the copier, book truck to transport journals, phone, email account
- Training needs: 1/2 day of hands on demonstration
- Promoted the importance of their role as a pilot project
 - Asked regularly for feedback on the mechanics of the project and solicited advice for the next group of interns
- Monthly meeting to re-group and address concerns


Work Flow

- Allow for customization
 - Explained preferred organization (i.e. 1 folder per title with a new spreadsheet and the pdf scans)
- Acknowledged lack of regional and library expertise
 - At all times a Librarian with regional expertise was available by phone, email, or in person
 - Any questions that could not be answered would be highlighted in red on the spreadsheet to be addressed later
 - Can not assume basic cataloging knowledge (NAR standardization, etc)





Lessons Learned

- More movement for the interns proved to be better than scanning within their work stations
- Greater need to check work more often to avoid the arduous task of checking all work at the end
- Greater detail added to the intern guide
- Added benefits of the project
 - Fully cataloging journals without full records
 - Correcting egregious mistakes in a cost-effective manner



Next Steps

- Interns / Volunteers / NTEs needed for Summer 2019
- Greater collaboration- how to help other universities fill in our gaps?
- How to make data accessible now without a database?
 - ILS integration for ceased publications
 - Store data on MSU's database (not live)
- Research into other capture methods for universality and more secure back-up
 - Mandelay / ProCite / RefWorks / Zotero
