Job Placement Survey 2022

The Department of Library and Information Science at the Catholic University of America conducted a job placement survey of the 31 graduates who graduated in Spring 2022, Summer 2022, and Fall 2022. Eleven (35.5%) of the 31 graduates invited to participate took part in the survey. The following data are valuable for the department to learn the career development of graduates.

Major findings:

- 90.9% of respondents were employed full-time
- 81.8% of respondents were employed in a library or information setting before graduating from the program
- 81.8% of respondents were in a permanent employment position
- 90.9% were employed in a Library or Information Science Institution, such as academic library, public library, federal library, archives or special collections, etc.
- Most common job assignments the respondents were responsible for were reference/information services (72.7%), collection development/acquisition (54.6%), outreach (54.6%), administration (45.5%), archival and presentation (45.5%), circulation (45.5%), digital content management (45.5%), and patron programming (45.5%).
- 90.9% of respondents were satisfied with their current job
- 27.3% received a promotion and 27.3% received a raise upon granting of the MSLIS degree
- The average annual salary for 11 respondents was \$64,821
