88% of respondents list critical thinking, soft skills and writing as the knowledge, skills, and experiences CUA LIS students should possess upon graduating.

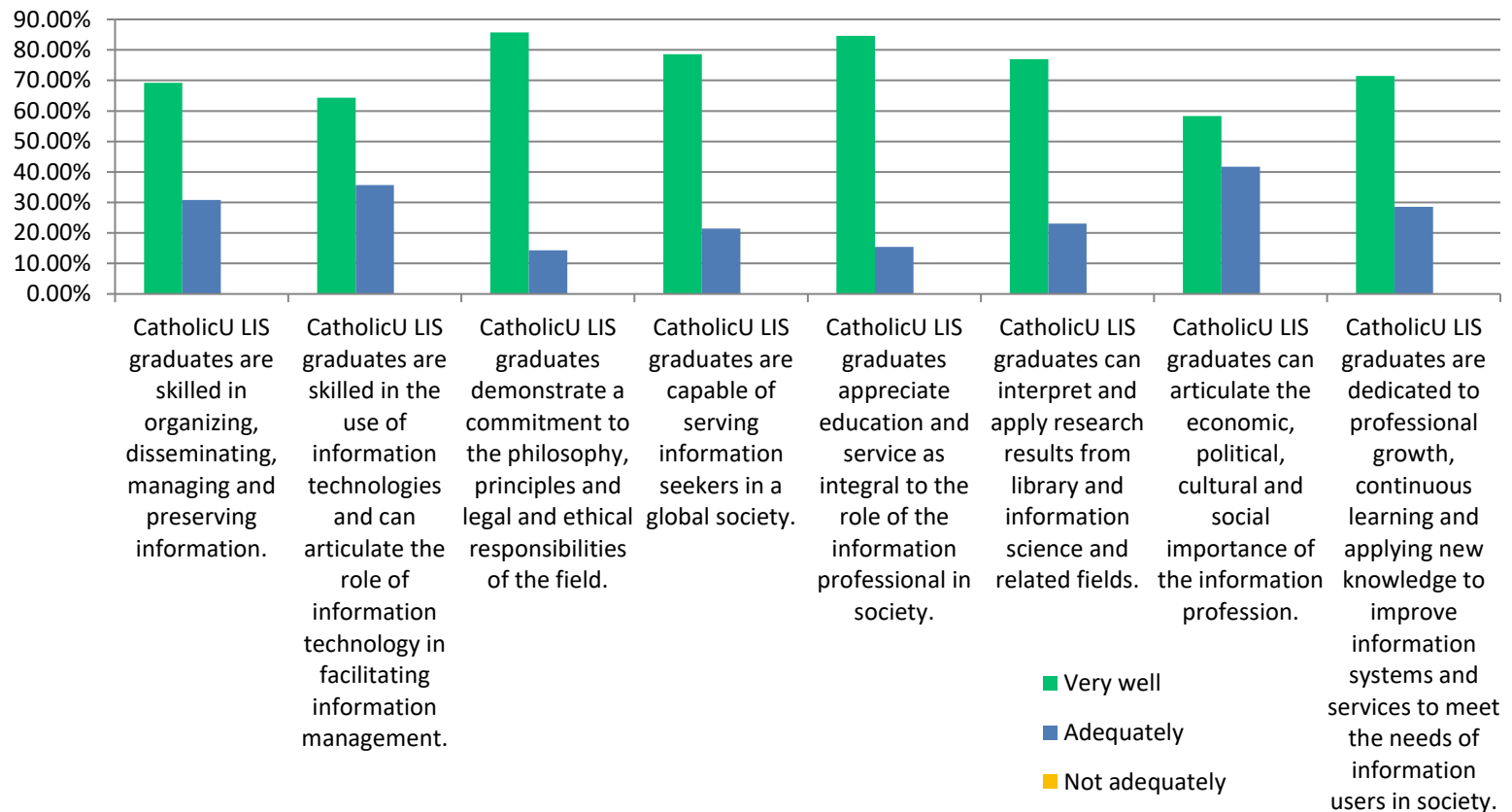


80% of respondents agree or very well agree that CatholicU LIS educates highly competent, ethical librarians and other information professionals

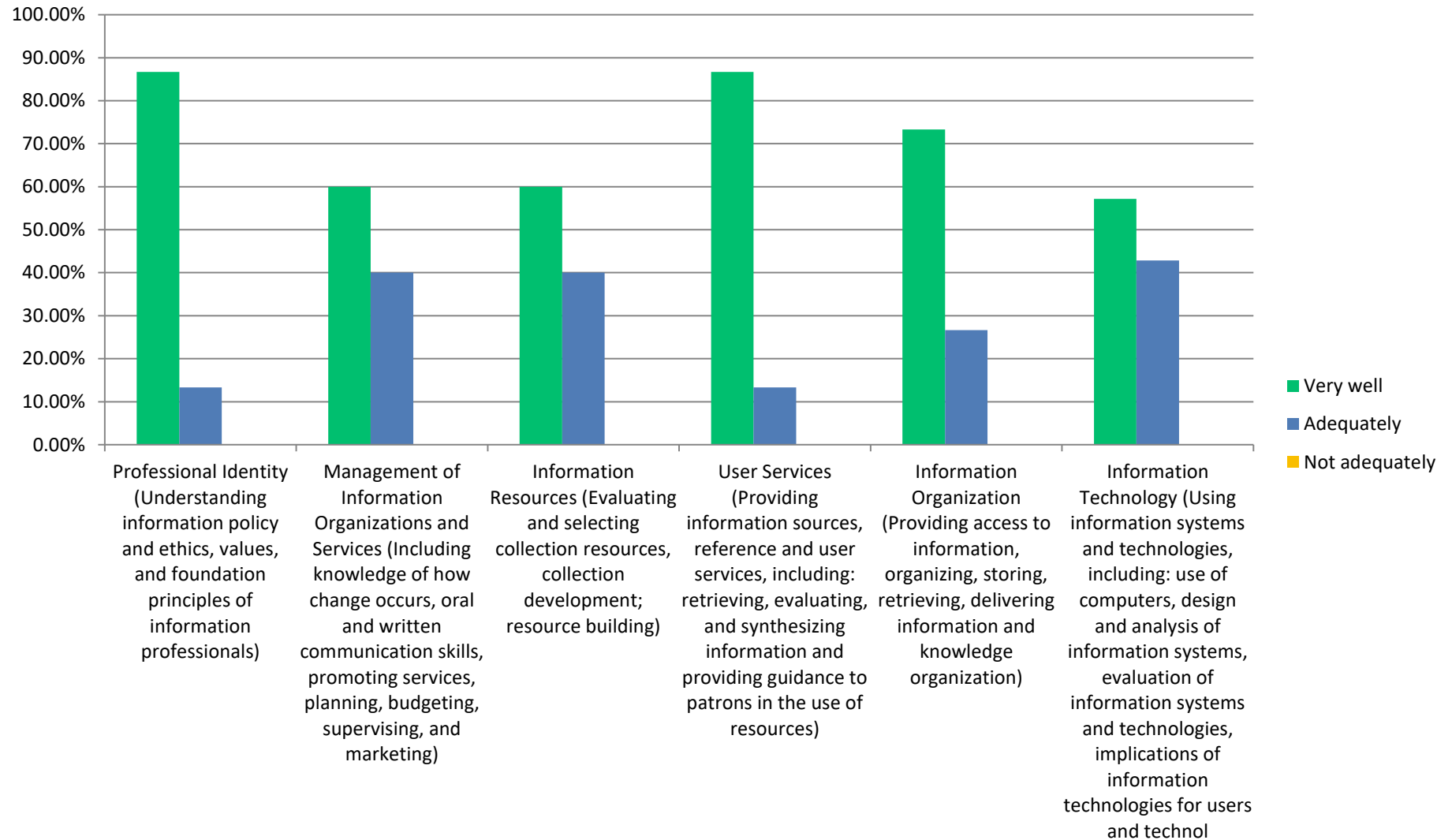


94% of respondents agree or strongly agree that CUA LIS graduates are effective team members and possess communication skills needed to be effective professionals.

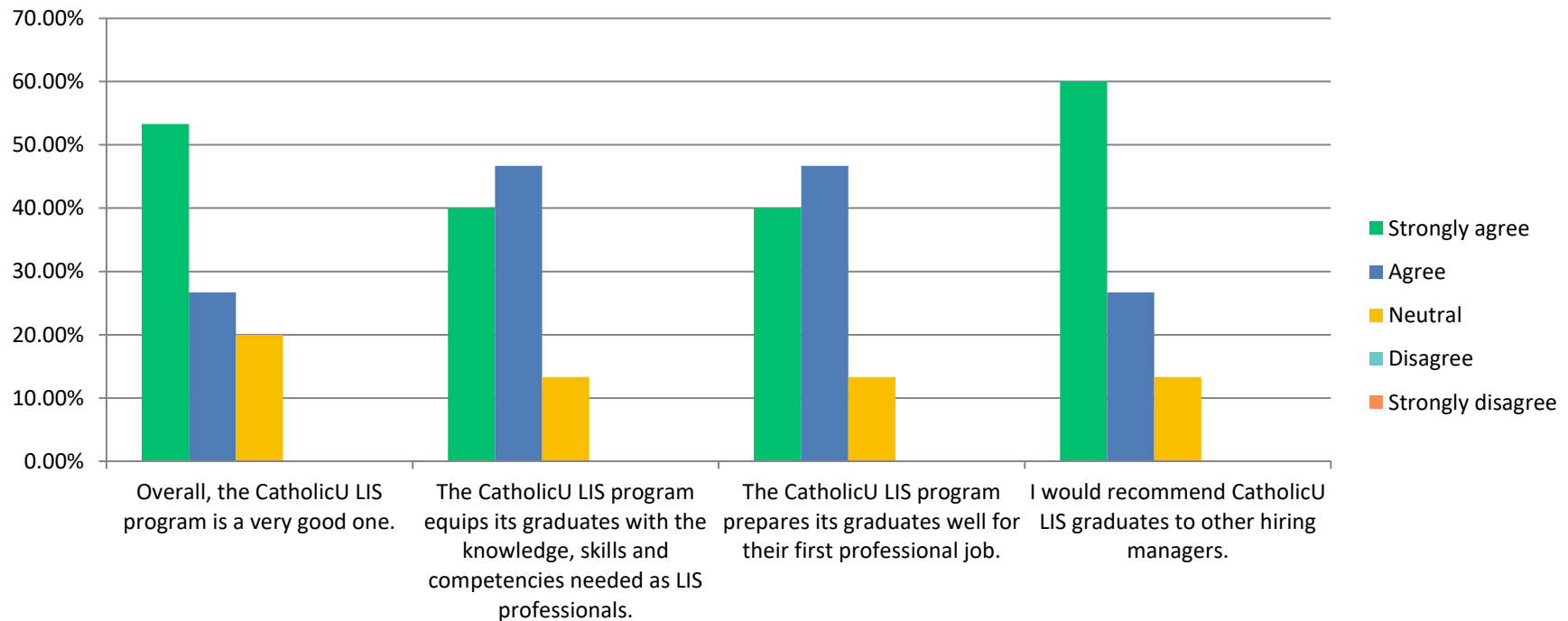

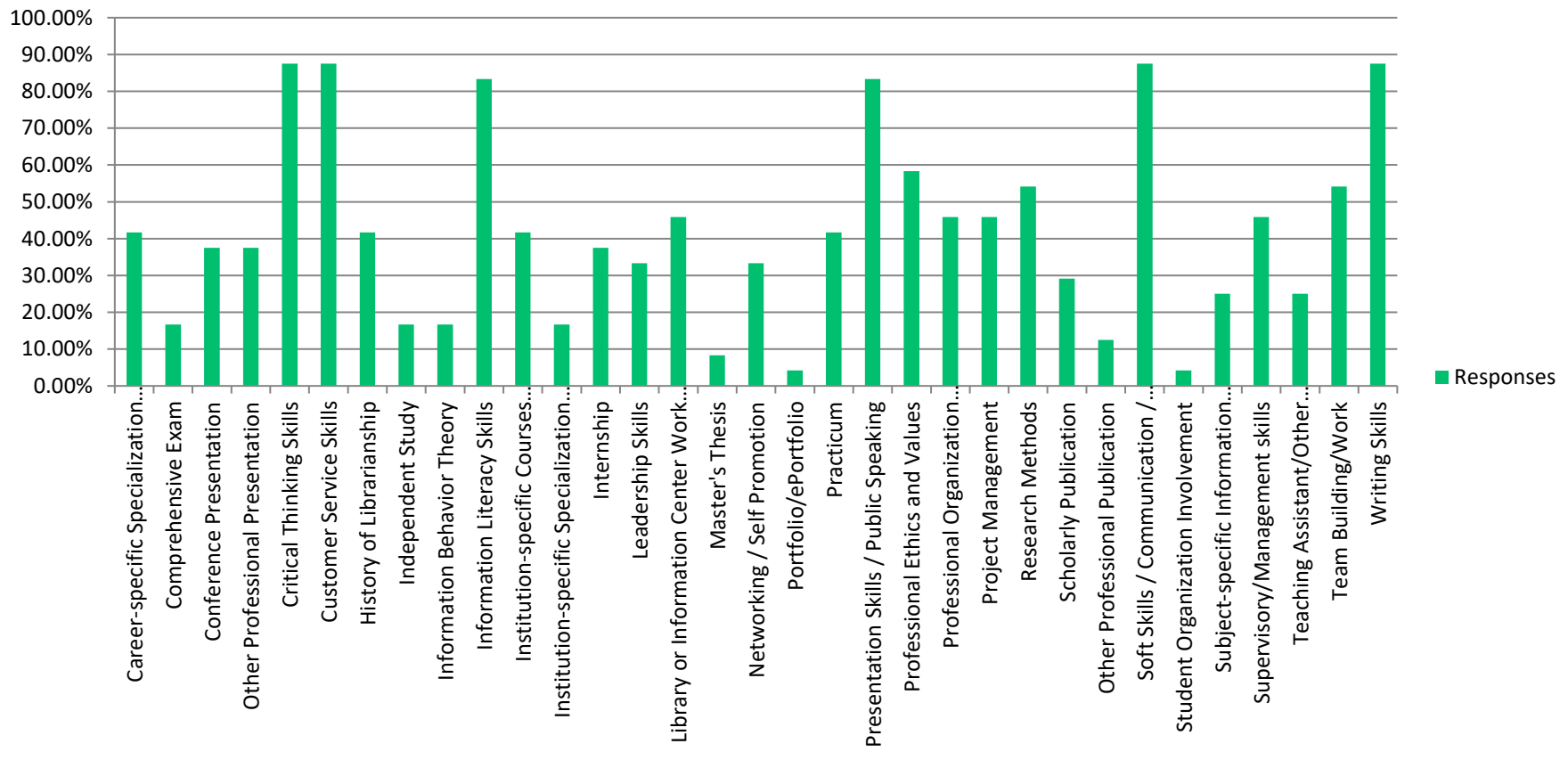

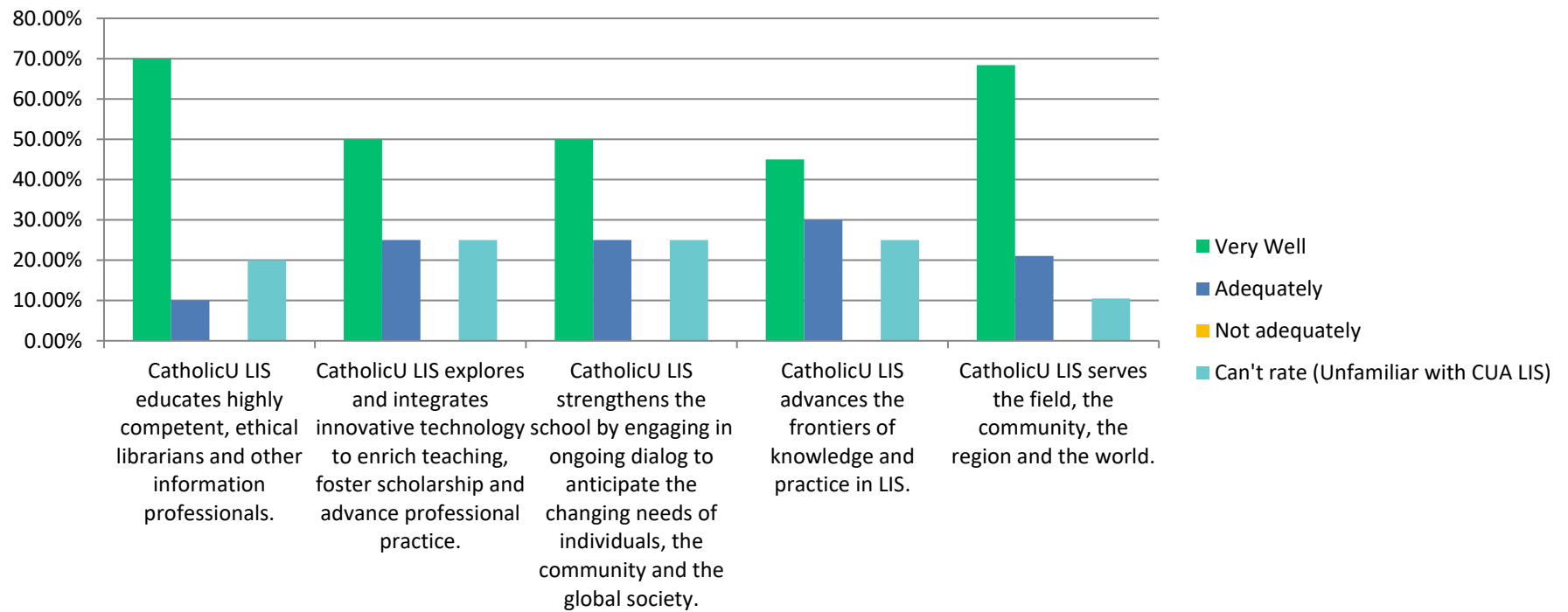
To what extent do you agree with the following statements based on your experience with the CatholicU LIS graduates you have interviewed, hired, supervised, or worked closely with in the last 5 years.
