About the Speaker:

During a career of over 30 years, Patrick Loughney has served as a cataloger, archivist, historian and curator of audio visual material produced since the 19th century. He has a Ph.D. in American Studies from George Washington University and currently serves as Chief of the Packard Campus for Audio Visual Conservation at the Library of Congress. During 2004 through 2008, Dr. Loughney served as Curator of the Motion Picture Department and Director of the L. Jeffrey Selznick School of Film Preservation at the George Eastman House Museum, Rochester NY.
